

Mt. Hood Women's Health Circumcision policy

After your 20 week visit and identifying the gender of your baby on ultrasound, our billing department will meet with you to discuss financial arrangements for the circumcision. If your prenatal care begins with us later in the pregnancy or your care has been transferred late to our clinic, our billing department will need to meet with you to discuss your financial requirements.

A circumcision is not a covered service by the Oregon Health Plan (OHP) with the exception of Family Care. Insurance coverage for this procedure varies by insurance plan. If you elect to have a circumcision for your newborn son, and it is not a covered benefit, you will be required to pay the office and the hospital prior to delivery. You will need to sign our Oregon Health Plan waiver for this procedure.

If you have OHP, two separate payments are required for a circumcision. Again, financial arrangements must be made prior to your hospital delivery. One pre-payment to Mt Hood Women's Health and a second pre-payment to the hospital. To obtain current fees and information you may from Legacy Mt Hood Medical Center please call 503-674-1122. The total fee is approximately \$500.00 payable in advance.
